CODE OF CONDUCT

ADDENDUM 1

(To be completed by all athletes entered in the 2009 World Age-Group Competition.)

Due to the fact that the USA Gymnastics T & T Team Members vary in age from 11 to 18, it is obvious that there are some special problems.

The freedom you will be given during any international trip will depend upon the circumstances (training and competition times, curfews set by coaches and team leader, etc.). However, during your free time, you must be tolerant of the restrictions placed on some because of their age.

Regardless of age, the USA Gymnastics Code of Conduct is in effect 24 hours a day and everyone will be expected to adhere to it. Therefore, any USA Gymnastics Team Member leaving the competition site, the hotel or any other place the USA Gymnastics Delegation has assembled, must sign out in person with the USAGTT Team Leader or someone appointed in his/her absence. No exceptions will be granted. Anyone not doing so is subject to any of the consequences listed in the USA Gymnastics Code of Conduct.

You must also sign in upon your return. Verbal permission can be granted if you do not plan to be gone for an extended period of time.

**CODE OF CONDUCT
ADDENDUM 2**

*(To be completed by all athletes entered in the 2009 World Age-Group
Competition who are 17 years and under)*

All athletes 17 years old and under must adhere to the following guidelines before being allowed to leave with any person other than USA Gymnastics Officials. Your child's safety and well-being are our primary concern!

1. No athlete will be allowed to leave the premises without prior approval from the Team Leader, or someone appointed in his/her absence.
2. Athletes must be signed out by an approved adult (see below) in the presence of the Team Leader, or someone appointed in his/her absence. Destination and approximate time of return must be noted.
3. Athletes must check in with the Team Leader, or someone appointed in his/her absence, immediately upon returning.
