Trampoline Gymnastics in Guadalajara 2011

Competition Date and Location

The Trampoline Gymnastics competition at the XVI Pan American Games Guadalajara 2011 will be held from **Sunday 16 to Tuesday 18, October 2011** at the Nissan Gymnastics Complex.

Events and Medals

The events to be held in the Trampoline Gymnastics competition of the Pan American Games Guadalajara 2011 are:

Competition Format

There will be two routines in the qualifying round. The first routine includes special requirements and the second is a voluntary routine according to the FIG and the UPAG Rules and Regulations.

Finals: there will be one voluntary routine in the finals open for both categories. All gymnasts from the qualifying round will go forward to the Finals.

Maximum Number of Competitors

According to the quota established by PASO, there will be a maximum number of sixteen (16) gymnasts: eight (8) Women and eight (8) Men.

NOCs may only send competitors who have qualified through the system established by FIG and UPAG for the XVI Pan American Games Guadalajara 2011.

Age of Competitors

Men's Trampoline = over seventeen (17) years old in 2011.

Women's Trampoline = over seventeen (17) years old in 2011.

Qualification System to Guadalajara 2011

The qualifying event for the XVI Pan American Games Guadalajara 2011 is the Pan American Cup 2010, held in Guadalajara on December 2-5, using the results of Competition I. The qualification applies to the countries and not to the Gymnasts.

Technical Meeting

- Team Leaders must collect their invitations for the Technical Meeting from the SIC at the Pan American Village upon arrival.
- The Technical Delegate and the Trampoline Gymnastics Competition Manager will preside over the meeting, which will be conducted in english and spanish.

Technical Officials

Technical Officials and Jury Members shall be appointed according the FIG and UPAG Rules and Regulations.

Protests and Appeals

Protests shall be resolved under the FIG regulations.

The Trampoline Gymnastics competition will take place in The Nissan Gymnastics Complex located at Lopez Mateos Sport Center at 2189 Colon Avenue, Zona Industrial, Guadalajara, Jalisco.
