ALABAMA Crimson Tide



For the second year in a row, Alabama opened up its season on the road at Auburn, and for the second year in a row, the meet came down to Alabama's last competitor. With the pressure on, sophomore Ashley Priess, for the second year in a row as well, clinched the Crimson Tide's 195.650-195.200 victory with a 9.9 on the balance beam. Alabama used five all-arounders against Auburn with sophomore Geralen Stack-Eaton leading the way, winning the all-around with a 39.225. Senior Morgan Dennis won the vault (9.9) and floor exercise (9.825), freshman Ashley Sledge won the uneven bars (9.825), and Priess won the balance beam. In addition to Sledge, rookie Marissa Gutierrez also made her Crimson Tide debut, competing on the vault and balance beam.

ARKANSAS Lady Razorbacks



No. 8 Arkansas opened the season with a 195.400-192.650 victory over No. 20 Arizona. Sophomore Jaime Pisani captured the all-around title with a 39.125 after tying for first on floor (9.850) and tying for second on bars (9.850). Seniors Amy DeFilippo (bars, 9.90), Casey Jo Magee (floor, 9.850, tie) and Sarah Nagashima (beam, 9.850) also claimed individual titles. Arkansas recorded a 49.200 on bars, which ties for the fifth-best mark in school history. Arkansas topped that score twice last year with a 49.225 at Kentucky, and at Oregon State and Cal. DeFilippo's 9.90 on bars ties for the fifth-best mark in school history and also ties for the best score by an Arkansas senior in the event. Pisani now has 15 event wins, including three all-around titles. DeFilippo has six event titles, including five on bars; Magee has 40, including four on floor; and Nagashima has three with two on beam.

AUBURN Tigers



Sophomore Allyson Sandusky matched a career-high on beam with a 9.8 in the opening meet of the season against Alabama. Sophomore Kylie Shields ranks 17th nationally in the all-around competition with a 39.050. The Tigers moved up five spots from 14th to 9th in the latest GymInfo poll following a 195.650-195.200 loss to then No. 3 Alabama on Friday. All three Tigers freshman who participated in the Alabama meet scored at least a 9.75 in their respective events. In the vault, Maya Wickus scored a 9.75 and Toi Garcia hit a 9.775. Petrina Yokoy scored a 9.8 on bars.

FLORIDA Gators



Florida faces No. 8 Arkansas in its 2010 home and Southeastern Conference opener on Friday, Jan. 15 at 7 p.m. (ET)...this is the first time since 2004 Florida opens its home schedule with a league opponent...Friday's meet will air tape-delayed on Charter Sports Southeast (CSS) on Jan. 19 at 7 p.m. Arkansas and Florida last met in 2009 NCAA Super Six team final competition...the Gators took fourth at 196.725 in their fourth consecutive NCAA Super Six appearance while the Razorbacks took fifth at 196.475 in their Super Six debut...in 2009 dual meet action between these two teams, Arkansas registered the first and only win the all-time series, taking a 196.375-195.425 win in Fayetteville, Ark. This is the second consecutive meet for Florida versus a top-10 opponent...UF opened the season with a 196.25-195.275 loss at then No. 9 Oklahoma on Jan. 8...the Gators had trouble on its opening event, as the final two performers in the uneven bars lineup had misses...the Gators couldn't make up the point deficit it spotted Oklahoma in the bars and finished 0.975 behind the Sooners in the final standings.

GEORGIA Gym Dogs



No. 1 Georgia (1-0) opened the 2010 season and the Jay Clark era with a 195.150-195.050 win over No. 7 Stanford last Saturday in front of a sellout crowd of 10,224 at Stegeman Coliseum. The Gym Dogs led at the end of each rotation, but Stanford rallied to take the lead late in the fourth rotation. However, senior Courtney McCool posted a clutch 9.925 on floor in Georgias final routine to lead the Gym Dogs to the narrow win. Georgia is now unbeaten in its last 29 regular season home dual meets and has won 19 straight meets at home...Senior Marcy Newby led the Gym Dogs with a 9.900 on vault while Gina Nuccio and Kat Ding posted team highs 9.850 on bars. On beam, senior Grace Taylor led the team with a 9.900It was Jay Clarks first meet as head coach. Clark previously served as an assistant of Georgias staff for 17 yearsThe tilt with Stanford was the first of three straight meets against top-10 opponents for the Gym Dogs, who will face a total of nine currently ranked teams in 2010Overall, the Gym Dogs have won 13 straight regular season meets and will put that streak on the line when they travel to Alabama Friday at 8:30 p.m. Eastern.

KENTUCKY Gym Kats



Kentucky won its season opener with a 194.850-187.250 victory over Texas Woman's University Jan. 9 at Memorial Coliseum ... The Wildcats swept all events and were led by sophomore Storey Morris who shared title honors in two events. Morris recorded a personal best in matching teammate senior Emily Green for first place on the beam with a 9.825. Morris also shared top honors on the uneven bars with teammates senior Jacque Behrendt and senior Jamie Reimann by scoring a 9.750 ...

Senior Hillary Ferguson and sophomore Whitney Rose shared title honors on the vault with a 9.850 ... Junior Jasmine Minion took title honors on the floor exercise with a 9.825 ... Junior Andrea Mitchell, who tied a personal best on the floor exercise with a 9.800, took first place in the all-around competition with a 38.800 ... Kentucky showed signs of progress from last season on both the uneven bars and the balance beam. UK's team score on the balance beam was higher than what the Wildcats scored during eight meets a year ago. Kentucky's 48.675 mark on the uneven bars scored higher than seven meets in 2009 ... UK travels to Las Vegas, Nev., to compete against LSU and Arizona State in the Lady Luck Invitational, Friday, Jan. 15. Rotations begin at 10 p.m. EST.

LSU Tigers



Sixth-ranked LSU (1-0) dominated Maryland, 194.375-190.625, in front of 1,661 fans at the Pete Maravich Assembly Center, marking the first time the Tigers opened the season at home since 2006 when LSU played host to the Super Six Challenge in the PMAC. All-American seniors Susan Jackson and Kayla Rogers led the Tigers with high scores as Jackson won the all-around for the sixth time in her career with a 39.275 while Rogers posted three scores of 9.80-plus. Jackson tallied LSU's first 9.90 score of the season by hitting that mark on floor while Rogers won her second career individual title and first on vault with a 9.875. In addition to the all-around and floor titles, Jackson won the bars title with a 9.825. Senior All-American Summer Hubbard picked up her fifth career beam title with a 9.800, and she also competed in the all-around for the first time in her career and finished with a 38.350. Up next, LSU will travel to Las Vegas for the Lady Luck Invitational where the Tigers will face conference foe Kentucky as well as Arizona State and Missouri.

ALL SEC TEAMS RECEIVE NATIONAL TOP 20 RANKINGS

The Southeastern Conference continues to prove itself as the nation's leading gymnastics conference. Each of the practicing seven SEC gymnastics squads currently find themselves ranked in the Top 20 of the polls. Alabama currently ranks No.4 in the nation. Arkansas, ranked 7th, is the next highest SEC team, followed by Florida (8th), Auburn (9th), Georgia (10th), Kentucky (14th) and LSU (16th). Jacksonville Veterans Memorial Arena (12,217)

The 2010 SEC Gymnastics Championship meet will be held March 27 in Jacksonville's Veterans Memorial Arena. This marks the 30th year that the SEC will crown a team champion in gymnastics. Alabama looks to defend its SEC crown, while Georgia, the 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2009 NCAA National Champions, will look to again claim the SEC title and take home their eighth SEC crown in the last 11 years. Florida will be aiming to win their second SEC title since 2007. LSU, who finished fourth last season, will also vie for the SEC Championship, as will 2008 NCAA-finalist Arkansas, Auburn and Kentucky.
