<p><b>No Contact</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Until June 15th</b> after completion of sophomore year.</li> </ul> <p><b>Printed Material</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No restrictions on design or content (after June 15th).</li> <li>• Size may not exceed 8.5x11 inches when opened in full.</li> <li>• May not be bound</li> <li>• Envelopes may not exceed 9x12 inches</li> </ul> <p><b>Electronic Materials</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Private messages only.</li> <li>• No public messaging/post</li> </ul> <p><b>Video/Audio Materials</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• May be created for recruiting purposes</li> <li>• May NOT be personalized</li> </ul>	<p><b>May <u>NOT</u> make or receive calls until June 15 after sophomore year.</b></p> <p><b>Non-Coaching staff</b> member may NOT make calls to PSA's except for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Related to camp logistics.</li> <li>• Day prior to &amp; during UNOFFICIAL visits.</li> <li>• 5 days prior to &amp; During OFFICIAL Visits</li> </ul>	<p><b>7 recruiting opportunities per PSA</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• per year (8/1-7/31) &amp; only 3 may be contacts with juniors &amp; seniors. May not occur during an evaluation, quiet or dead period.</li> </ul> <p><b>Contact may occur after competition concludes for the day &amp; the PSA has been released by coach</b></p>	<p><b>Anytime outside quiet or dead period.</b></p> <p>Limited to 7 recruiting opportunities per PSA per year (8/1-7/31)</p> <p>Only Evaluations made 9/1-5/31 count against the 7 total recruiting opportunities.</p> <p>An evaluation made on the same day as a contact only counts as a contact (<u>one recruiting opportunity</u>)</p> <p><b>Non-Coaching staff</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• may evaluate recruiting video &amp; identify PSAs, but may <b>NOT</b> attend events in their sport involving PSAs unless an immediate family member is participating; information is not relayed back to coaches; and no direct contact is made with other PSAs/Coaches at the event.</li> </ul>	<p>PSA may take a total of <b>5</b> official visits &amp; only <b>ONE</b> per school</p> <p><b>May not occur during a dead period</b></p> <p><b>Transportation Cost:</b> PSA only</p> <p><b>Meals &amp; Lodging</b> PSA &amp; up to 4 family members during the 48 hour period</p> <p><b>Complimentary admissions:</b> PSA &amp; up to 4 family members</p> <p><b>Reserving Game Tickets:</b> May reserve additional tickets for purchase at face value</p> <p><b>May decorate for visits</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Only in athletic facilities not open or visible to public while decorating</li> <li>• Decorations may not be personalized for a specific recruit</li> </ul>	<p><b>May not occur during a dead period.</b></p> <p><b>Transportation</b> Within a one-mile radius of campus &amp; to home athletic facilities</p> <p><b>Complimentary admissions:</b> PSA &amp; up to 2 individuals (+2 additional comps for nontraditional family members)</p> <p><b>Reserving Game Tickets:</b> May reserve additional tickets for the purchase at face value</p> <p><b>May decorate for visits</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Only in athletics facilities not open or visible to public while decorated</li> <li>• Decorations may not be personalized for a specific recruit</li> </ul>

\*PSA- Prospective Student Athlete, this is anyone who has started classes for the ninth grade, or above, as well as students who have officially withdrawn from a four year institution and plan to transfer to an other institution.
