

## USA Gymnastics Championships COVID Protocol FAQ

### **Where should credentialed Participants upload pre-event test results?**

There will be a web app made available later the week of 6/14. Watch your email! Tier 2 Participants are permitted to bring their results in person, but this will slow down the registration line, so we ask that you upload them ahead of time to the web app, if possible.

### **I see that testing for family members staying with credentialed Participants is recommended. Where do family members upload results?**

Family members do not need to upload their test results. This recommendation for testing is an additional layer of protection for our athletes.

### **Can I get a rapid test?**

Rapid PCR or Molecular testing (like ID Now) is approved but rapid antigen testing is not approved.

### **If I am competing, coaching, or judging in some elite events and some development events, what tier am I?**

If you are an athlete, coach or judge in ANY elite events, you are always Tier 1.

### **What are the hours for onsite testing for the 2<sup>nd</sup> test for Tier 1 Participants?**

Please arrive for testing at least 2 hours before your scheduled training time. The current test hours (subject to additions) are:

  - 6/22: 6:30 AM-7:30 AM, 9 AM-10 AM, 3 PM-4 PM, 8-10 PM
  - 6/23: 6:30 AM-9:30 AM, 8 PM-9 PM
  - 6/24: 2 PM-3 PM
  - 6/25: 4 PM-5:30 PM
  - 6/26: 11 AM-12 PM
  - 6/27: 4 PM-5 PM

### **What if I can't make one of the above testing times due to my travel and training schedule?**

**I'm having a hard time finding a place to get tested that works with my schedule. Any suggestions?**

Many previous credentialed participants have used [Pixel](#) tests. Pixel will mail you the test kit, you swab at home and FedEx it back (in a pre-paid envelope). Results are typically received within 1-2 days. Walgreens and CVS also offer PCR and molecular testing--even on the weekends. Walgreens has an ID Now test that is a rapid molecular test and results will be ready in a short time. Tier 2 participants can also use the onsite testing facility at the Hyatt St. Louis Arch hotel as their pre-event test. There is a charge of \$135 for Tier 2 participants who wish to use this option at the Hyatt.
