Virtual Livestream Inquiry Process

1. A virtual inquiry is only allowed during a livestream competition; inquiries are not allowed during a “video submission/upload” format type of virtual competition.
2. Coaches are entitled to see all scores of their individual gymnasts. Inquires may be based only on the following:
 - a. Compulsories – Incorrect elements, evaluation of major elements, falls, neutral deductions or unusual occurrences.
 - b. Optionals – Awarding of Start Value, specific “flat” compositional deductions, falls, neutral deductions or unusual occurrences.
3. Inquiries must be submitted to the Meet Referee within 5 minutes of the completion of the squad’s competition on that event. The Meet Director must communicate with all participants how to submit inquires to the Meet Referee; some examples are via text, email, or other shared form of communication.
4. Once required documentation is received by Meet Referee, the judges on that event will then be notified that an inquiry has been submitted.
5. Judges will meet in separate location (break-out room, phone call, etc.) to discuss with Meet Ref. Chief Judge is responsible for completing the response to the inquiry.
6. Meet Ref will update coach once a decision has been made.
7. No signatures are necessary.

Meet Director responsibilities

- establish pre-meet information, including the following regarding the virtual inquiry process:
 - o Inquiry process and how to submit
 - o Meet Referee name and contact information
 - o Link to Virtual Sanctions resource page on USA Gymnastics website for form retrieval
- establish separate judge breakout room for inquiries (if applicable)
