Commitment to Participant Welfare

- Maintain current commercial general liability insurance that includes, at minimum, participant liability and participant accident medical insurances.
- Employ at least one staff member who is 18 years of age or older and holds a current Professional or safety-certified Instructor membership in USA Gymnastics.
