## SAFE SPORT INFORMATION

Athlete safety and well-being are USA Gymnastics' highest priority, and the USA Gymnastics Safe Sport Policy is one of the most powerful tools the organization has for athlete protection. As a gymnast, you need to be aware the Safe Sport Policy provides important requirements, including:

1. Prohibiting sexual abuse, physical abuse, emotional/verbal abuse, bullying, hazing and harassment;
2. Requiring mandatory reporting of suspected or known abuse or misconduct;
3. Setting Preventive Policies that forbid one-on-one interaction between adults and minors, identifying other boundary violations and grooming behaviors.

## MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT

This Membership Agreement ("Agreement") relates to specific types of membership and is intended to be read in conjunction and as a supplement to, while not replacing but only amending where applicable, the Terms and Conditions governing use and access to [www.usagym.org](http://www.usagym.org). This Agreement creates a legally binding agreement between you and USA Gymnastics ("USA Gym," "we," or "us"). As used in this Agreement, the words "you", "your" or "user" are synonymous and refer to the person using the site or services.

In consideration of your membership in the USA Gymnastics, Inc. ("USA Gymnastics"), and your desire to participate in USA Gymnastics-sanctioned, -sponsored, or other events, you agree to this Agreement:

### GENERAL AGREEMENT

Membership in USA Gymnastics is a privilege and may be (i) denied, withheld, or non-renewed at any time by USA Gymnastics in its sole discretion and / or (ii) suspended or terminated based upon USA Gymnastics' policies and standards.

You agree that as a member of USA Gymnastics you have read, understand and agree to abide by and be bound to the USA Gymnastics Bylaws, Safe Sport Policy, and the Code of Ethical Conduct. You also agree that all safe sport rules, policies and procedures whether published by USA Gymnastics or the U.S. Center for SafeSport ("Center"), as well as all applicable criminal codes, govern your conduct. You specifically acknowledge and consent to the jurisdiction of the U.S. Center for SafeSport, and you agree that any sanctions imposed by the Center or USA Gymnastics extend to your participation in all National Governing Body events or other activities. You agree that sanctions, whether interim or final, may be posted on our website or in other public forums and may include information identifying you and describing the misconduct at issue.

### USA GYMNASTICS POLICIES

You agree that you will become familiar with and be bound by all policies that apply to you or your membership with USA Gymnastics. These include, but are not limited to: rules of competition, USA Gymnastics SafeSport Policy and Code of Ethical Conduct, all applicable U.S. Center for SafeSport Policies, handbooks and regulations, anti-doping rules and policies, and any other rules and policies as may be amended from time to time. You also agree that we may require you, as a condition of continuing your membership, to obtain additional training or other information related to certain designated subjects, you will do so in accordance with all applicable deadlines.

### READINESS TO COMPETE

You agree that you will only participate in those USA Gymnastics competitions for which you are physically and psychologically prepared to compete. Prior to participation in any USA Gymnastics-sponsored, -sanctioned or other event(s), you agree to have sufficiently and proficiently practiced your exercises and agree to only perform those exercises which you have accomplished to a degree of confidence necessary to assure that you can perform them by yourself, appropriately and without unreasonable risk of injury.

### MEDICAL ATTENTION

You give your consent to USA Gymnastics, its employees, agents or other authorized personnel, to include but not limited to the Host Organization of any USA Gymnastics sponsored, sanctioned or other event, to provide through medical personnel of its choice, customary medical or athletic training attention, transportation and emergency medical services as required in the course of your participation in USA Gymnastics sponsored, sanctioned or other events. You agree that USA Gymnastics is not a covered entity or medical provider as those terms are defined by the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (110 Stat. 1936 et seq.), and that USA Gymnastics does not hold itself out as a provider of medical services.

### WAIVER AND INDEMNITY

For USA Gymnastics, the entire and exclusive liability of USA Gymnastics shall be as stated in the USA Gymnastics bylaws and other policies, including these and any other applicable terms. You agree not to hold USA Gymnastics liable for any loss or damage incurred as a result of your membership. Your exclusive remedy shall be as set forth in these terms.

You further acknowledge and affirm that you are fully aware of, and appreciate the risks inherent in the sport of gymnastics. Such risks may include but are not limited to catastrophic injury, paralysis and death.

To the maximum extent permitted by law, in no event shall USA Gymnastics (including its officers, directors, employees and agents), or any hosting organization be liable to you for any loss, damage or injury of any kind including any direct, indirect, special, incidental, exemplary, consequential or punitive losses or damages, or damages arising out of or in any way related to your membership or your participation in a USA Gymnastics sponsored, sanctioned or other event.

You release USA Gymnastics (including its officers, directors, employees and agents), and/or any hosting organization, from any claims, losses or damages or any kind arising from or in any way connected with your membership or your participation at an event, including claims, losses or damages arising from or occurring as a result of the negligence of any party with the exception of claims based upon the intentional or reckless conduct of any party.

The foregoing does not affect any liability which cannot be excluded or limited under applicable law.

USA Gymnastics reserves the right to investigate and prosecute any suspected breaches of this Agreement. USA Gymnastics may disclose any information as necessary to satisfy any law, regulation, legal process or governmental request.
