Following the completion of the Olympic Team selection, the Olympic Selection Committee was tasked with confirming the athletes who would be invited to the 2021 World Championship Trials taking place September 14-19, 2021. The selection procedures for World Championships can be found here:

The Committee named the automatic invitations based on the criteria in Section 1.2.2.b. Brody Malone, Yul Moldauer, Sam Mikulak, Shane Wiskus, and Alec Yoder all earned automatic invitations by being named to the Tokyo Olympic Team.

Alex Diab earned an automatic invitation by achieving a final score of 14.9 on SR on Day 2, which would have placed within the top 3 at 2019 World Championships in Rings Finals.

None of the remaining achieved the Individual Event criteria for automatic selection. Additionally, there were no petitions submitted to the Olympic Selection Committee for invitation to the 2021 Worlds Trials. Therefore, the remaining invitations would come from Discretionary Criteria.

The Committee looked at each of the Individual Event specialists and felt that they were all deserving of an invitation to the World Trials based on their performances at Olympic Trials. The Committee chose to invite Donnell Whittenburg, Gage Dyer, and Stephen Nedoroscik to the World Trials.

The Committee evaluated all other participants from Olympic Trials and felt that the remaining athletes were similar AA athletes. There was discussion about not inviting any more athletes, but the Committee felt that there were other athletes deserving of an invitation. With no clear

standouts for individual events, the Committee elected to invite the next two highest AA athletes: Brandon Briones and Akash Modi.

The Committee went through the Individual Event results a final time and determined that Cameron Bock finished with three top 5 finishes on Pommel Horse, Parallel Bars, and High Bar, which was the most of any athlete that had not already been invited to Trials. The Committee decided that Cameron Bock was deserving of an invitation to Worlds Trials.

A total of 12 athletes will be invited to the 2021 World Championship Trials:




